SacCounty Is Back In The State's Most Restrictive Tier

Closed

- Amusement parks
- Indoor playgrounds, bounce centers, laser tag
- Nightclubs
- Live theater
- Bars, breweries and distilleries where no meals are provided

Open indoors, with modifications

- Banks
- Personal care services, including nail salons, tattoo parlors, piercing shops, non-healthcare massage services and estheticians
- Childcare
- Clothing and shoe stores: maximum 25% capacity
- Doctors and dentists
- Barber shops and hair salons
- Dry cleaners and Laundromats
- Indoor shopping malls: capacity must be limited to 25%. Food courts and common areas must be closed.
- Bookstores: maximum 25% capacity

Open outdoors only, with modifications

- Wedding ceremonies
- Restaurants
- Places of worship and cultural ceremonies
- Yoga studios
- Movie theaters
- Museums
- Family entertainment centers, including go-kart racing, mini golf and batting cages
- Dance studios
- Cardrooms
- Wineries
- Fitness centers and gyms

Schools

If a school has opened for in-person instruction, they may remain open at their current level of operation. If a school has not yet opened for in-person instruction, they cannot do so until SacCounty returns to the red tier. Elementary schools may submit a waiver application.
