Who is eligible for services?

- Individuals age 12 and over living in Sacramento County experiencing substance use problems (some services available to 18+)
- Eligibility is based on full scope Medi-Cal and/or the lack of insurance that covers Substance Use treatment services

Preference for Substance Use Treatment Services provided to:

(Injecting pregnant women receive preference in the following order):

- Pregnant and injecting drug users
- Pregnant substance abusers
- Injecting drug users
- All others

Community Treatment Services

- Education Groups
- Outpatient Treatment/Intensive Outpatient Treatment
- Perinatal Services (pregnant and parenting women)
- Residential Treatment
- Withdrawal Management/Detoxification
- Medication-Assisted Treatment (methadone, buprenorphine, naloxone and disulfiram, Narcan)
- Sober Living Environments/Recovery Residences
- After Care Services/Recovery Support Services
